Maths: In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognising acute, right and obtuse angles and compare angles.• Drawing lines of a given length and identify perpendicular and parallel lines.• Revising lines of symmetry in shapes and sort 2D shapes according to their properties, including the number of right angles, perpendicular and parallel lines and lines of symmetry.	
Literacy: In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provide a link between fiction and non-fiction texts.• Develop their awareness of writing for a specific purpose and audience.• To recap the rules for making singular nouns plural.	
Other: We will also be learning about: Science: Recognise the difference between a parallel and series circuit. Computing: create a multi-track composition in GarageBand. DT: Design a pencil case. Art: Explore the influence and legacy of Sonia Delaunay. Geography: Identify the position and significance of the Prime/Greenwich Meridian.
