



Weekly Overview Year 1	
Week Beginning: 21 st February 2022	
Words of the week: We will be using the following words in our lessons this week: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Count• Fives• Tens• Pattern• Altogether	
Maths: In Maths this week we will be learning to recognise odd and even numbers. We will be counting objects in 5s and 10s, and beginning to say 5 lots and 10 lots. We will also be finding half, quarter and three quarters of shapes and learning that two halves and four quarters are a whole and that two quarters is a half.	
Literacy: In Literacy this week we will be learning about the story 'Unfortunately'. We will be completing several activities around this book over the next two weeks. This week we will be discussing what a story could be about based on the front cover, sharing our own fortunate and unfortunate experiences (focusing on understanding this vocabulary), predicting what will happen next in the story and then acting it out, learning to read the story with expression and ordering the story using before, during and after. We will also be focusing on the suffixes 's' and 'es' this week. The children will now be attending shorter RWI lessons and completing daily guided reading sessions with their class teacher. Handwriting – capital S, T and U.	
Other: We will also be learning about: Science – sorting a set of animals using a branching database. RE – knowing and understanding how we show that we belong. History – chronologically order significant events. Music – listening and appraising 'Round and Round' by Joanna Mangona. Art – creating light and dark shades of colour. Computing – looking at how to create a multimedia eBook about our achievements. DT – designing a house. PE – developing control and co-ordination when dribbling a ball with our hands. Also, performing basic movements to music and building a simple themed dance focusing on the Weather (rain). Don't forget it is our PE day on Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school, is not wearing jewellery and has a hair tie on this day.
