



Weekly Overview Year 1

Week Beginning: 28th February 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- Fire
- Smoke
- Burn
- London
- Firefighter

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning doubles to double 10. We will also be recapping pairs to 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 and linking this to related subtraction facts. We will be using our knowledge of pairs to 10 to make pairs to 20. We will also be using number facts to solve word problems.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be continuing to learn about the story 'Unfortunately'. The activities that we will be completing this week include acting out ideas that link to the story and our own experiences, creating our own map which shows a series of fortunate or unfortunate events and writing a recount. We will also be editing our writing. Furthermore, we will be learning what a question mark is and when it should be used. The children will now be attending shorter RWI lessons and completing daily guided reading sessions with their class teacher.

Other:

We will also be learning about:

Science – sorting animals into the correct group.

RE – understanding significant life events and how they might be celebrated.

History – creating a newspaper report about the Great Fire of London.

Music – playing instruments to accompany 'Round and Round' by Joanna Mangona.

Art – creating a painting using light and dark shades of colour.

Computing – selecting and importing images for an eBook.

DT – continuing to design a house.

PE – exploring accuracy when rolling a ball and building a simple themed dance focusing on the Weather (wind).

Don't forget it is our PE day on Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school, is not wearing jewellery and has a hair tie on this day.
