<p><b>Words of the week:</b></p> <p>We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Naughty</li> <li>• Notice</li> <li>• Occasion</li> <li>• Perimeter</li> <li>• Opinion</li> </ul>
<p><b>Maths:</b></p> <p>In Maths this week we will be learning about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tell the time on a 24-hour clock, use am and pm correctly, convert pm times to 24-hour clock and vice versa</li> <li>• Measure and calculate perimeter of shapes where each side is labelled in cm and m</li> <li>• Convert from one unit of length to another and solve word problems involving mixed units of length</li> </ul>
<p><b>Literacy:</b></p> <p>In Literacy this week we will be learning about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop their confidence and skills in script planning and development</li> <li>• Read and share their play scripts</li> <li>• Evaluate their own and their partner's work against specific criteria and then discuss how they could improve their work</li> <li>• Proofread their work and make changes to improve the accuracy of their grammar, punctuation and spelling</li> <li>• To use the suffix 'ation'</li> </ul>

To give a simple opinion about a colour.
