



Weekly Overview Year 1	
Week Beginning: 21 st March 2022	
Words of the week: We will be using the following words in our lessons this week: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thursday • Tuesday • Wednesday • February • August 	
Maths: In Maths this week we will be learning to add a 1-digit number by counting on from a 2-digit number, whilst not crossing the 10s at first. Then as the week progresses, beginning to cross the 10s barrier. We will also be subtracting a single-digit number by counting back from numbers up to 30, not crossing 10s. Finally, we will be subtracting single-digit numbers from multiples of 10.	
Literacy: In Literacy this week we will be proofreading and editing some of our work from last week. We will be learning about first and third person. We will be identifying examples of first person pronouns and third person pronouns. This half term, we previously learnt about the 'Great Fire of London' in history. This week, we will be revisiting this topic and completing a range of literacy activities around this event. We will be looking at some Great Fire of London poems and the children will be writing their own poem. We will also be reading a range of books on the Great Fire of London and focusing on comprehension questions related to these texts. The children will now be attending shorter RWI lessons and completing daily guided reading sessions with their class teacher.	
Other: We will also be learning about: Science – creating a 'What am I?' about an animal, using descriptive language. RE – understanding how Muslims welcome the birth of a baby. History – researching the Wright brothers. Music – listening and appraising the song 'Why don't you' by Gramophonedzie. Art – finishing our piece of art based on the work of Kandinsky. Computing – adding images from the Internet to our eBooks. DT – continuing to follow our designs to make our houses. RSE – understanding the characteristics and mental and physical benefits of an active lifestyle. PE – exploring control and co-ordination when dribbling a ball with our feet and copying, repeating, creating and performing actions that represent a theme. Don't forget it is our PE day on Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school, is not wearing jewellery and has a hair tie on this day.
