<b>Week Beginning:</b> 18 <sup>th</sup> April 2022	
<b>Words of the week:</b> We will be using the following words in our lessons this week: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Popular</li><li>• Position</li><li>• Possession</li><li>• Stamina</li><li>• Alarm</li></ul>	
<b>Maths:</b> In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Reading, writing and comparing 4-digit numbers and placing them on a line.</li><li>• Finding 1000 more or less than any given number.</li><li>• Beginning to read, write and compare 5-digit numbers, recognising what each digit represents.</li></ul>	
<b>Literacy:</b> In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be introduced to vocabulary specific to the culture in the story.</li><li>• Become familiar with Story version 1, the bare bones of the story.</li><li>• Make connections to the story and the setting.</li><li>• Keep a personal log of notes, thoughts and ideas, collected from their reading and discussions.</li></ul>	
<b>Other:</b> We will also be learning about: Science: Research Ivan Pavlov and write a clear biography. History: Explain when and where the Vikings came from and say why they raided Britain. Computing: Create simple tessellations. Music: Begin to recognise the style indicators of The Beatles' songs. PE: Develop sending a ball with a push pass. Develop stamina and an understanding of speed and pace to distance. RE: Know and understand that people express spiritual views through art. Art: Explore and examine buildings in a range of architectural styles. DT: Investigate what alarm systems are used for and how different types of switches are activated. French: Understand and use <i>j'ai</i> and know the difference between <i>j'ai</i> and <i>je suis</i> . Year 4 Library day is Monday, please ensure your child brings their library book back every Monday. Don't forget it is PE day on Thursday, please ensure your child has their PE kit in school, any earrings are taken out and hair is tied back. As we continue rehearsing for our Year 4 performance please can children be reminded to bring in their play scripts everyday if they are taking them home to practise.
