



Weekly Overview Year 1
Week Beginning: 25 th April 2022
<p>Words of the week:</p> <p>We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fruit • Sour • Juicy • Sweet • Bitter
<p>Maths:</p> <p>In Maths this week we will be learning and understanding that two-digit numbers are some 10s and some 1s and then identifying these. Also, we will be using number facts to add and subtract 1-digit numbers to 2-digit numbers. Furthermore, we will be adding pairs of 1-digit numbers that have totals above 10.</p>
<p>Literacy:</p> <p>In Literacy this week we will be learning about poetry. We will be reciting one stanza of a poem and performing this to the class. We will be using illustrations and descriptive labels to show what happens in a poem. We will also be collecting poetry ideas on a nature walk to help support us with writing descriptive words and phrases. Finally, the children will be writing a descriptive poem based on their ideas from their nature walk.</p> <p>In grammar, we will be looking at words which include 'ph' and words which include 'wh'. We will be completing daily guided reading sessions and additional Phonics sessions in class.</p>
<p>Other:</p> <p>We will also be learning about:</p> <p>Science – identifying the different parts and functions of a plant.</p> <p>RE – understanding what Christians believe about God.</p> <p>Geography – identifying the equator and surrounding countries and features.</p> <p>Music – listening and Appraising 'Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious' from Mary Poppins.</p> <p>Art – continuing to explore African colours, shapes and patterns.</p> <p>Computing – creating sound patterns in ScratchJr and GarageBand.</p> <p>DT – describing a variety of fruits and vegetables.</p> <p>PE – developing a foundation for balance and stability.</p> <p>Don't forget it is our PE day on Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school, is not wearing jewellery and has a hair tie on this day.</p> <p>Over the next couple of weeks, the children will have the opportunity to participate in cooking lessons.</p>
