| Maths: In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To read, use and compare negative numbers. • To use negative numbers in the context of temperature. • To have knowledge of factors and reasoning to solve problems. | |
| Literacy: In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To explore strong descriptive phrases and think about how they help the reader engage with a story. • To explore how the author uses dialogue and description of the action to help the reader visualise how characters behave. • To use evidence from the story to compose questions that will elicit a deeper understanding of the main character. • To know the rules for using is and are. | |
| Other: We will also be learning about: Science: Label the main organs of the body. History: Compare the significance of some Anglo-Saxon kings during the Viking period. Computing: Create more complex tessellations. Music: Include an instrumental part to a familiar song. PE: Develop receiving the ball. Develop power and speed in the sprinting technique. RE: Know and understand how Christians express important views through art. Art: Explore the architecture of Sir Christopher Wren. DT: Investigate how to create circuits with a variety of different switches. French: Understand someone asking how old they are (<i>quel âge as-tu?</i>) and reply using a sentence stating their age.
