Maths: In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multiply and divide numbers by 10 and 100 including decimals. • Read and write decimals (to 1 and 2 places), understanding that these represent parts (tenths and hundredths) of numbers. • mark 1- and 2-place decimals on a line and round decimals to the nearest whole number. 	
Literacy: In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn how to compose descriptive sentences about the setting. • To see a story grow through three stages of development. • To develop imagery (similes and metaphors) to describe the bus. • To learn the rules for an or a. 	
Other: We will also be learning about: Science: To understand how the digestive system works. History: Learn about the later Viking raids, the actions of Kings Ethelred II and the introduction of Danegeld. Computing: To program Islamic-style art in Scratch. Music: To improvise using voices and instruments. PE: Develop dribbling using the reverse stick. Develop technique when jumping for distance. RE: To know and understand that Christians express important views through music. Art: To explore colour and pattern in the design of St. Basil's Cathedral. DT: To design an alarm system for a particular purpose. French: To understand the difference between le/la/les and un/une in French and know when to use each type of article.
