



## Weekly Overview Year 1

**Week Beginning:** 9<sup>th</sup> May 2022

### Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- Weight
- Heavy
- Light
- More
- Less

### Maths:

In Maths this week we will be recapping how to add and subtract 10 from 2-digit numbers. We will also be learning how to compare weights using direct comparison, and we will be measuring weight using uniform non-standard units. Furthermore, we will be completing tables and block graphs. Some of the key vocabulary that we will be using includes weight, heavier, heaviest, lighter, lightest, more, less, bigger, smaller, higher and lower.

### Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be continuing to develop our understanding of poetry. We will be reading and discussing a range of nature poems. We will be identifying our favourite poems and then explaining why. We will also be exploring rhyming words. We will be identifying rhyming words within poems and then writing our own words. Furthermore, we will be thinking of suitable adjectives and phrases that can be used to describe minibests and then creating a short descriptive paragraph about a minibest. Finally, we will be continuing to complete daily Phonics sessions in class.

### Other:

We will also be learning about:

Science – creating a fact file about Carl Linnaeus.

RE – knowing and understanding what the Bible teaches Christians about God.

Geography – plotting human and physical features on a map.

Internet Safety – understanding how to be respectful, responsible and safe online.

Art – exploring Maasai jewellery and culture.

DT – examining, tasting and describing a variety of fruits and vegetables.

Music – learning to sing the song ‘Your Imagination’.

PE – exploring hopping, leaping and jumping from a distance.

Don’t forget it is our PE day on Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school, is not wearing jewellery and has a hair tie on this day.
