<b>Week Beginning:</b> 16 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	
<b>Words of the week:</b> We will be using the following words in our lessons this week: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Regular</li> <li>• Reign</li> <li>• Remember</li> <li>• Composition</li> <li>• Teeth</li> </ul>	
<b>Maths:</b> In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recognise and read Roman numerals to 100, and begin to know the history of our number system including 0.</li> <li>• Calculate area and perimeter of rectangles and simple rectilinear shapes.</li> <li>• Recognise, name and classify 2D and 3D shapes, identifying regular and irregular polygons, and sort 2D shapes according to properties including types of quadrilaterals and triangles.</li> </ul>	
<b>Literacy:</b> In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use their developed plan to write their new episode of Hamid's journey.</li> <li>• Read and share their episode of Hamid's journey.</li> <li>• Evaluate, proofread their work and make changes to improve the accuracy of their grammar, punctuation and spelling.</li> </ul>	
<b>Other:</b> We will also be learning about: Science: Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions. History: Explain how the legal system worked in Anglo-Saxon and Viking Britain. Computing: To create art inspired by the later work of Bridget Riley. Music: To arrange a performance including improvisation and composition. PE: Use an open stick tackle to gain possession. Develop a pull throw for distance and accuracy. RE: To know and understand how Islamic art expresses the concept of Allah. Art: To examine the architecture of the Sydney Opera House. DT: To evaluate a finished alarm system. French: To create sentences using the language <i>j'adore/ je déteste ... mais je voudrais</i> . Year 4 Library day is Monday, please ensure your child brings their library book back every Monday.
