



Weekly Overview Year 1

Week Beginning: 23rd May 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- Queen
- Jubilee
- Royal
- British
- Majesty

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning to find half of all numbers to 10 and then to 20 and identifying even numbers. We will be learning to recognise halves and quarters of shapes and begin to know that $2/2 = 1$, $4/4 = 1$ and $2/4 = 1/2$. Furthermore, we will be learning to recognise, name and know the value of coins 1p-£2 and £5 and £10 notes. We will be solving repeated addition problems using coins and making equivalent amounts using coins. Finally, the children will be completing problem solving questions which involve money.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be completing a range of different phonics activities, preparing for the Phonics Screening Test which will take place the first week back after half term. We will be recapping set 1-3 sounds and also recapping additional sounds that could be in the test (ie, au, e-e, ck, kn, ue etc). We will be focusing on identifying special friends within real words and nonsense words. Additionally, we will be completing split-diagraph activities (a-e, o-e, i-e etc).

Other:

We will also be learning about:

Science – writing about the steps we need to take when planting seeds and how to care for our plant.

Art – creating flags for the Queen’s Jubilee.

History – ordering a time line of events from the Queen’s life.

Music – continuing to play instruments alongside ‘Your Imagination’.

Computing – recording audio in GarageBand and experimenting with audio effects.

PE – throwing for accuracy.

Don’t forget it is our PE day on Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school, is not wearing jewellery and has a hair tie on this day.

We have an off curriculum day on Friday, where we will be participating in activities to celebrate the Queen’s Jubilee.

Please remember, we have the Phonics Screening Test the first week back after half term. Please do encourage your child to practise their Set 1-3 sounds and recognising special friends in real words/ nonsense words whilst they are at home.
