Words of the week: We will be using the following words in our lessons this week: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sentence • Separate • Special • Responsibilities • Faith 	
Maths: In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compare 2-place decimals in the context of lengths and use relative lengths to solve measures problems. • Add and subtract 0.1 and 0.01 and say a number one-tenth (0.1) or one-hundredth (0.01) more or less than a given number. • Recognise decimal and fraction equivalents. 	
Literacy: In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Become familiar with some of the key features of persuasive writing. • Plan the message and purpose of their advertising campaign and design a poster for it. • See a model of using music, images and words to create a trailer. • Evaluate their own work against specific criteria and then discuss how they could improve their work. 	
Other: We will also be learning about: Science: Conduct an investigation to understand how to keep teeth healthy. History: Explain how the last Anglo-Saxon King shaped Britain. Computing: Create art inspired by the early work of Bridget Riley. Online Safety: Understand and respect digital rights and responsibilities. Music: Perform confidently as a class. PE: Develop officiating and performing skills. Apply defending and attacking principals and skills in a hockey tournament. RE: Express my own view of faith through art. Art: Design a building for a particular purpose. French: Practise opinion phrases <i>j'adore/ je déteste</i> ... and extending sentences with <i>mais</i> . RSE: Understand simple self-care techniques. Learn about the safety of medicine and household products.
