



## Weekly Overview Year 5

**Week Beginning:** 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2022

### Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- Counting
- Subtraction
- Division
- Divide
- Problem
- Solve
- Knowing

### Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

We will continue to have children in streamed groups which have appropriate learning objectives for the children. These groups will focus on times tables up to 12 x 12 and associated number facts.

In Miss Biant's group we will be looking at subtraction using column methods. Practising times tables.

In Miss Shaw and Miss Fixter's groups will be using 5-digit numbers using written column addition; subtract 5-digit numbers using written method (decomposition); check answers to subtractions using written column addition; solve subtractions of 4- and 5-digit numbers using written column subtraction or number line counting up.

We will be encouraging the children to use the new interactive 'Times Tables Rock Stars' or 'TTRS' all children will have been given log in details for this exciting new times tables platform.

### Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

In Miss Fixter and Miss Shaw's group will be evaluating fairy tales with an alternate ending.

In Miss Biant's group, we will be looking at writing Autobiographies and biographies.

You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.

### Other:



We will also be learning about:

Music – Practising songs for the year 5 production

PE – Basketball and athletics skills.

Computing – Looking at how to create interactive slide shows. Presenting a presentation using hyperlinks.

RE – Looking at what it means to be a part of the Muslim faith.

Art – Looking at Chinese art. Chinese calligraphy.

We will be continuing to observe E safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect.

Don't forget it is PE day on Monday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day.

We have also sent out reading records – all children's log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
