



## Weekly Overview Year 5

**Week Beginning:** 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022

### Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

### Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

We will continue to have children in streamed groups which have appropriate learning objectives for the children. These groups will focus on times tables up to 12 x 12 and associated number facts.

In Miss Biant's group will be beginning to multiply fractions less than 1 by whole numbers, convert improper fractions to whole numbers; use short multiplication to multiply 3-digit and 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers; use long multiplication to multiply 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by teens numbers.

In Miss Shaw and Miss Fixter's groups will be finding the area and perimeter of squares and rectangles by calculation and pursue a line of enquiry; estimate and find the area of irregular shapes; calculate the perimeter and area of composite shapes; use the relations of area and perimeter to find unknown lengths; begin to understand the concept of volume; find the volume of a cube or cuboid by counting cubes; understand volume as measurement in three dimensions; relate volume to capacity; recognise and estimate volumes

We will be encouraging the children to use the new interactive 'Times Tables Rock Stars' or 'TTRS' all children will have been given log in details for this exciting new times tables platform.

### Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

In Miss Fixter and Miss Shaw's group will be looking at biographies and writing them

In Miss Biant's group, we will be looking at writing fairy tales and beginning to plan one for writing.

You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.
