# Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

## Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

- Use the vertical algorithm (ladder) to multiply 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers.
- Find non-unit fraction of amounts.
- Add fractions with like denominators, including totals greater than 1.
- Divide by 10 and 100 (to give answers with one and two decimal places).

# Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

- To create and develop a plan for their own story by adding detail, dialogue and action.
- To write their own version of the story.
- To evaluate their own and their partner's work against specific criteria and then discuss how they could improve their work.

We will also be learning about:

Science: To conduct an experiment to identify sound insulators.

History: Learn about the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun.

Computing: To use the photo collection to make predictions about the weather.

Music: To learn to play a tune.

PE: To dodge a defender and move into space when running towards the goal.
