Week Beginning: 4th July 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

We will continue to have children in streamed groups which have appropriate learning objectives for the children. These groups will focus on times tables up to 12×12 and associated number facts.

In Miss Biant's group will be beginning to add and subtracy units of money mentally.

In Miss Shaw and Miss Fixter's group will be using short division to divide 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers and 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, including those which leave a remainder; express a remainder as a fraction; use long multiplication to multiply 3-digit and 4-digit numbers by teens numbers.

We will be encouraging the children to use the new interactive 'Times Tables Rock Stars' or 'TTRS' all children will have been given log in details for this exciting new times tables platform.

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:
