<b>Week Beginning:</b> 11 <sup>th</sup> July 2022	
<b>Words of the week:</b> We will be using the following words in our lessons this week: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Isolation</li><li>• Loneliness</li><li>• Virtual</li><li>• Power</li><li>• Tournament</li></ul>	
<b>Maths:</b> In Maths this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Divide by 10 and 100 (to give answers with one and two decimal places).</li><li>• Use mental strategies and tables facts to divide 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers to give answers of between 20 and 50, with and without remainders.</li><li>• Find non-unit fractions of amounts.</li></ul>	
<b>Literacy:</b> In Literacy this week we will be learning about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To read a newspaper article and identify how it might be improved.</li><li>• To use source material to write a section for the class newspaper.</li><li>• To proofread and evaluate their own work against specific criteria.</li><li>• To prepare and organise their writing for publication.</li></ul>	
<b>Other:</b> We will also be learning about: History: Compare and contrast the powers of different Egyptian Gods. Computing: To deliver a weather forecast and reflect on learning. Music: To practice a learnt tune. PE: To use action and reaction when creating ideas with a partner. To apply the rules and skills you have learnt and play in a tag rugby tournament. RE: To know and understand how the world can be repaired. RSE: To understand that isolation and loneliness can affect children and that it's very important to discuss your feelings with an adult and seek support. Online Safety: To understand the importance of being careful when talking to virtual friends. French: Revise opinions and connectives. Learn about location of Paris.
