Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse.

We will also be looking at place value of up to 5 digit numbers as well as addition and subtraction of 4 and 5 digit numbers using the place value method.

In Numeracy we have also been looking at place value within 5 digit numbers. We will be using this knowledge to add and subtract 1's, 10's, 100's, 1000's and 10,000's mentally using place value swaps.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

Traditional fairy tales as well as 'twisted' fairy tales and using our imagination to describe a main character in a different way to the original story.

We will be describing characters in depth, using varied sentence starters as well as expanded noun phrases and descriptive sentences.

We will also continue to look at the weekly spellings and rules associated with those spellings. We will use dictionaries to understand the meaning of the words as well as being able to write them in context within a variety of sentences

Other:

We will also be learning about:

We have been learning a song called 'Livin' on a Prayer' by Bon Jovi – we will be performing this in the class together.

We will be developing and furthering our knowledge of Ancient Greece, particularly the schooling surrounding Athens and Sparta. The children will be debating and sharing their opinions on which school they would attend in Ancient Greece.

Don't forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day. Wearing PE kits to school and for the day enables us to take full advantage of the PE lesson without the time loss involved when getting changed. We will be doing a mixture of team building games as well as 5 Ash going swimming on Wednesdays.
