

Weekly Overview Year 2

Week Beginning: 10th October 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- door
- floor
- poor
- because
- find

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be finding fact families and recording known facts in different ways within addition and subtraction calculations. We will be exploring strategies for learning number bonds and considering which facts we need to learn off by heart. Furthermore, we will be using known facts with 1s to determine other facts with corresponding multiples of 10. Finally, we will be using our knowledge of number bonds to learn complements of 100; 10 + 90, 20 + 80, 30 + 70, and so on. Times tables -10s.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be finishing our stories. Then, we will be proofreading and editing our work. We will also be looking at how we can improve the language used within our stories. We will revisit when to use capitals letters within our writing (start of a sentence, an independent 'I' and for character names). We will also be thinking about how we can include question marks and exclamations marks within our writing.

Other:

We will also be learning about:

Science – understanding the importance of eating the right types of food.

Music – listening and appraising 'Hlokoloza' by Arthur Mofokate.

Computing – using selective editing tools.

Art – creating paintings using the Aboriginal dot style.

History – planning our own Carnival.

RE – continuing to develop our understanding that the Qur'an is the Muslim holy book.

PE (team building) – working as a group to solve problems.

PE (dance) – performing in unison creating shapes with a partner.
