



Weekly Overview Year 5

Week Beginning: 10th October 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

Place value within decimal numbers and rounding a decimal number to one or two decimal places.

Calculations involving decimal numbers and the best way to solve these calculations.

Multiplying decimal numbers using place value.

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at number and place value within our problem solving sessions.

We will be continuing our TTRS times tables and division calculations and recollection skills fortnightly and as Early morning work.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

How to make links and connections with other stories and their own experiences – looking at real life events and how these can be implemented into stories.

Writing a viewpoint of a story from a main character's point of view and talking about the term bias and how this can relate to our own writing.

How to use the bare bones of a story to create the main summary and points of a written/oral story.

We will continue to look at the weekly spellings and the rules associated with these spellings along with dictionary skills and writing the spelling words in context within sentences.

Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week.

Other:

We will also be learning about:

We will be performing 'Livin' on a Prayer' by Bon Jovi as well as using instruments alongside the song. The children will have a chance to use the glockenspiels. We will be making videos of the children's performances.

We will be using our artistic knowledge to create a piece of art linked to our surrounding area. We have studied the outdoor area of school and researched the local area online.

In computing we will be moving onto planning a story board for an online game that year 5 children can play. We will be using associated gaming software on the school Ipads. We will be continuing to observe safety in all of our computing/ cross curricular computing lessons.

Annie Edwards will be in once again to focus on RSE lessons and we will be talking about relationships.

Don't forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day. We will be doing a mixture of dance, Netball and Swimming on a Wednesday.

We have also sent out reading records – all children's log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
