Week Beginning: 17th October 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- kind
- mind
- behind
- child
- children

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning to add and subtract 1s to or from a 2-digit number without exchanging, using number bonds to help us. We will be adding two single digit numbers that total more than 10, by breaking one number into two parts to bridge the 10. We will also be adding three numbers presented in a variety of ways, including concrete and pictorial representations. We will be selecting the most appropriate resource to help us and rearranging the numbers to add efficiently.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about non-fiction books. We will be discussing the features of a non-fiction text and looking at different examples of these. We will be writing an informative text on 'How to look after a budgerigar (budgie). Furthermore, we will be recapping what a verb is and identifying examples of these.

Other:

We will also be learning about:

Science – describing the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).

Music – using ipads to explore sound, electricity, pitch and resistance (Music Workshop). **Computing** – explaining how we edited our photos.

Art – continuing to create paintings using the Aboriginal dot style.

History – participating in a Carnival for Black History Month.

RSE – understanding personal boundaries and what makes a happy friendship.

PE (team building) – working as a group to solve problems.

PE (dance) – copying, creating and performing actions considering dynamics.
