



Weekly Overview Year 5

Week Beginning: 17th October 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at number and place value within our problem solving sessions and then moving onto time conversions.

We will be looking at 12 and 24-hour time as well converting times in to 12/24 hour. We will be creating time tables for TV guides using 24 hour times. Children will be finding the time of a given number of minutes, or hours and minutes later, e.g. 1 hour 25 minutes after 13:45.

We will be looking at drawing accurately using cm/mm.

We will be looking at time related word problems in our problem solving sessions and as plenaries at the end of the maths lesson.

We will be continuing our TTRS times tables and division calculations and recollection skills fortnightly and for early morning work.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

In some of our classes, we will be focusing on the end of our fiction writing unit, writing a Greek myth in the first person and character of Pandora. We will have acted out role plays from the story as well as examining speaking and listening skills in all literacy groups. Some classes will be planning their writing and using their ideas to write a story in first person.

We will continue to look at the weekly spellings and the rules associated with these spellings along with dictionary skills and writing the spelling words in context within sentences.

You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week.

Other:

We will also be learning about:

We will be performing ‘Livin’ on a Prayer’ by Bon Jovi as well as using instruments alongside the song. The children will have a chance to listen and watch each other’s performances. We will be videoing the children using the musical instruments as well as singing the song.

Children will be able to examine and talk about the pitch, temp and range within the song performed.

In our history lesson we will be creating a textured picture of Medusa, also linking to our art lessons.

In RE we will continue to learn about the Sikh religion, including the teachings of the Gurus, worship in the Sikh religion as well as certain celebrations that take place.

Children will write a letter/post card about their imaginary visit to the Golden Temple in India.

We will be continuing to observe safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect. In particular, we will be looking into how to stay safe on line and creating a poster with rules for children about how to stay safe online when browsing, gaming etc.

Don’t forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day. We will be doing a mixture of netball and Swimming on a Wednesday.

We have also sent out reading records – all children’s log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
