<p>Words of the week:</p> <p>We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide • Describe • Different • Portrait • Evaporation
<p>Maths:</p> <p>In Maths this week we will be learning about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Place value in decimals, recognising the relationship between tenths and decimals • Place value in decimals and recognising that if we divide a 2-digit number by 10 we may get a decimal number • Adding two 4-digit numbers using written methods
<p>Literacy:</p> <p>In Literacy this week we will be learning about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How information texts are written with a specific audience and purpose in mind • How to compose research questions and use them to focus on the relevant information • How an article is structured to make it easy for readers to find information, using key features e.g. <i>headings, subheadings, boxed text</i> • Revise suffixes including –s and –es
<p>Other:</p> <p>We will also be learning about:</p> <p>Science: recognise the process of evaporation by conducting an experiment.</p> <p>History: discuss and understand the meaning of the terms ‘invaders’ and ‘settlers.’</p> <p>DT: explore different ways to join fabric using sewing skills.</p> <p>Art: continue to recreate Warhol’s ‘Campbell’s Soup’ artwork using polystyrene sheets.</p> <p>Music: learn to play a melody using C, D, E and F.</p> <p>PE: learning the techniques for different passes in netball.</p> <p>RE: know and understand Sukkot.</p> <p>British Values: learn about Remembrance Day and hold a two-minute silence.</p> <p>Year 4 Library day is Monday, please ensure your child brings their library book back every Monday.</p> <p>Don’t forget it is PE day on Wednesday, please ensure your child has their PE kit in school, long hair is tied back and any earrings are taken out.
