

#### Weekly Overview Year 5

# Week Beginning: 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022

# Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

### Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

Learning objectives may differ in Miss Jose's group.

We will be looking at factors of numbers as well as fractions, leading children onto adding fractions.

We will be using mental strategies to multiply and divide multiples of 10 and 100; use a written method to multiply 3-digit and 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers and estimate answers, divide 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers using a written method and express remainders as a fraction and solve division word problems.

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at numbers that are divisible by 2,3,4,5,6,9.

We will be continuing our TTRS times tables.

#### Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

Miss Jose's literacy group will be editing their stories.

Other groups will be looking at how to follow instructions and what makes a good instruction text as well as creating their own set of instructions.

We will continue to look at the weekly spellings and the rules associated with these spellings along with dictionary skills and writing the spelling words in context within sentences.



You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.

## Other:

We will also be learning about:

DT – Building bridges and how arches are used to strengthen bridges.

Music – We will be continuing our new unit 'Classroom jazz' in particular 'The three note Bosa' by Ian Gray where children will become familiar with the instruments used within Jazz.

Science – We will be continuing to learn about Earth and the solar system in particular naming the planets independently as well as the features of the planets. Describing the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system by examining the geocentric and heliocentric theories.

PE – Learning the skills to create a dance

Computing – we will be cracking codes using the Caesar Cipher code.

RE – We are continuing with our unit on Sikhism and the importance of religious festivals including Diwali and the importance of the 5 K's.

We will be continuing to observe E safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect.

In RSE we will be looking at basic first aid, where children will be learning about how they can help each other if someone hurts themselves.

Don't forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day.

As it is non – uniform day on Friday, please ensure that children wear something that is suitable for PE lessons.

We have also sent out reading records – all children's log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
