



Weekly Overview Year 5

Week Beginning: 28th November 2022

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- Straw

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

Learning objectives may differ in Miss Jose's group.

Times tables up to 12 x 12 and associated number facts.

Looking at fractions as part of a whole as well as being able to recognise and make equivalent fractions.

Measuring angles and using a protractor.

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at numbers that are divisible by 2,3,4,5,6,9.

We will be continuing our 'TTRS' times tables and division calculations.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

Miss Jose's literacy group will be writing instructions using a guided model.

Other groups will be looking at how to follow instructions and what makes a good instruction text as well as creating their own set of instructions.

We will continue to look at the weekly spellings and the rules associated with these spellings along with dictionary skills and writing the spelling words in context within sentences.

You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.

**Other:**

We will also be learning about:

DT – Building bridges and how decks strengthen bridges. We will be making our big build very soon which will incorporate all of the ideas that we have looked at this half term!

Music – We will be continuing our new unit 'Classroom jazz' in particular 'The three note Bosa' by Ian Gray where children will become familiar with the instruments used within Jazz. We will be using the glockenspiels to add our own notes to the musical piece.

Science – We will be continuing to learn about Earth and the solar system in particular being able to understand and explain how the moons phases happen.

PE – Learning the skills of Gym.

Computing – we will be cracking codes using our own version of the Caesar cipher code.

RE – We are continuing with our unit on Sikhism and the importance of religious festivals including Diwali and the importance of the 5 K's. we have been thinking about places that are special to us and how they make us feel.

We will be continuing to observe E safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect.

In RSE we will be looking at basic first aid, where children will be learning about how they can help each other if someone hurts themselves.

Don't forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day.
