Maths:
In Maths this week we will be learning about:
Learning objectives may differ in Miss Jose's group.
Times tables up to 12 x 12 and associated number facts.

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at numbers that are divisible by 2,3,4,5,6,9.

We will also be completing our half termly assessments in maths lessons, which comprise of arithmetic and reasoning tests.

We will be continuing our 'TTRS' times tables and division calculations and recollection skills.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

The similarities between Earth and Mars.

We will continue to look at the weekly spellings and the rules associated with these spellings along with dictionary skills and writing the spelling words in context within sentences.

You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.



Other:

We will also be learning about:

DT – This week we will be both finishing and evaluating our 'Big build' The children have all worked very hard to incorporate arches, pillars and trusses as well as suspension methods into their bridge to try and test with toy cars and weights. Look out for evidence on Marvellous me!

Music – We will be finishing our new unit 'Classroom jazz' in particular 'The three note Bosa' by Ian Gray where children will become familiar with the instruments used within Jazz. We will be using the glockenspiels to add our own notes to the musical piece. These performances will be videoed for children to be able to watch back and evaluate. Science – Describing the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth by explaining how

the Moon orbits the Earth.

Computing – we will be evaluating the codes that we have been looking at over the past few weeks.

RE – We are continuing with our unit on Sikhism in particular to know and understand how Sikhism works in relation to the modern world.

We will be continuing to observe E safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect.

In RSE we will be looking at basic first aid, where children will be learning about how they can help each other if someone hurts themselves.

Don't forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day. We will be doing a mixture of dance and gym.

We have also sent out reading records – all children's log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
