



Weekly Overview Year 5

Week Beginning: 16th January 2023

Words of the week:

We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

- Babies
- Emotional
- Terminology
- Scientific
- Changes

Maths:

In Maths this week we will be learning about:

We will continue to have children in streamed groups which have appropriate learning objectives for the children. These groups will focus on times tables up to 12 x 12 and associated number facts.

In Miss Jose's group, we are looking at addition and subtraction methods involving 3, 4, 5 and 6 digit numbers.

In Miss Shaw and Miss Biant's groups we will be recapping mental addition strategies for decimals and whole numbers; use counting on as a strategy to perform mental addition of 2-place decimals to the next whole number; solve missing number sentences; use mental strategies to solve multi-step word problems; use counting up as a strategy to perform written subtraction.

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at numbers that are divisible by 2,3,4,5,6,9.

We will be continuing our TTRS times tables and division calculations and recollection skills fortnightly and during morning sessions.

Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

In Miss Biant's and Miss Shaw's group we will be moving onto the reading and writing of fiction, in particular making links between texts.

In Miss Jose's group, we will be using our knowledge of the 'Bling' story to decide on the main characters fate.



You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.

Other:

We will also be learning about:

Music –We will be continuing our new piece of music which is Adele’s ‘Make you feel my love’ and playing the glockenspiels alongside the music.

Science – Comparing the rate of growth in babies.

PE – we will be focussing on ball skills which will enable us to play small games of tennis.

Computing – We will be able to begin to build a virtual gallery.

RE – continuing to look at and describe sources of wisdom within religion.

We will be continuing to observe E safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect.

Don’t forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day.

We have also sent out reading records – all children’s log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
