We will be using the following words in our lessons this week:

Maths:	
In Maths this week we will be learning about:	
Using rules of divisibility to find if numbers are divisible by 2, 3, 4, 5, 9 and 10; identity prime numbers; revise finding factors of numbers; find squares and square roots of	
square numbers; finding patterns and making and testing rules; use mental multiplication	
and division strategies; relate mental division strategies to multiples of ten of the divisor	
We will continue to have children in streamed groups which have appropriate learning	
objectives for the children. These groups will focus on times tables up to 12 x 12 and	
associated number facts.	

Problem solving using a variety of skills, including addition and subtraction. We will also be able to identify whether an answer is correct by using the inverse. Problem solving will take place during most Numeracy lessons. We will be looking at numbers that are divisible by 2,3,4,5,6,9.

We will be encouraging the children to use the new interactive 'Times Tables Rock Stars' or 'TTRS' all children will have been given log in details for this exciting new times tables platform.

## Literacy:

In Literacy this week we will be learning about:

Writing poetry using similes and metaphors for imagination.

We will also be conducting our half termly assessment for Comprehension.

You will find that some spellings are repeated during the half term/term, this is due to the fact that there may be misconceptions for some words e.g. to, two, too (synonyms) and we want the children to be able to use these correctly and in context within a sentence. Many of our weekly spellings fall in line with topics covered and provide cross – curricular links across the year 5 subjects this week and other weeks.



## Other:

We will also be learning about:

Music –We will be continuing our new piece of music which is Adele's 'Make you feel my love' and evaluating our own version of the song.

PE – we will be focussing on ball skills which will enable us to play small games of tennis. Computing – Assessing our galleries.

RE – Assessment about sources of worship and guidance.

We will be continuing to observe E safety in all of our computing lessons as well as any cross curricular lessons that include computing as an aspect.

Don't forget it is PE day on Friday, children need to wear their PE kits to school on that day.

We have also sent out reading records – all children's log in details are in there. We will check reading records every Monday and check for two signatures from an adult at home.
